Dear Mr. Ward:

I have examined management's attached assertions about operational compliance with certain requirements of its TSCP SHA1 Bridge CA and TSCP SHA256 Bridge CA (collectively referred to as "TCBA") including all associated Registration Authorities and Certificate Status Authorities and its Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the US Federal PKI Bridge Authority and all of its cross-certified members as defined in policies and practices listed that were in effect during the period December 1, 2017 and November 30, 2018.

The management of TSCP is responsible for compliance with those provisions. My responsibility is to express an opinion on management's assertions about compliance, including the conformity of its Certification Practice Statements with its Certificate Policy, and its conformance with its MoAs with the US Federal Bridge Authority and all of its cross-certified members, based on my examination.

My examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, and, accordingly, included examining, on a test basis, evidence about compliance with those provisions and performing such other procedures as I considered necessary in the circumstances. I believe that my examination provides a reasonable basis for my opinion. My examination does not provide a legal determination on compliance with specified provisions.

In my opinion, management's assertions regarding compliance, including the conformity of its Certification Practices Statements with its Certificate Policy, with the aforementioned provisions and its assertion of compliance with its MoA with the US Federal PKI Bridge Authority and all of its cross-certified members from the period December 1, 2017 to November 30, 2018 is fairly stated, in all material respects.
